

Town of Triana
Regular Council Meeting
Monday, April 27, 2020
6:30 p.m.

The Mayor called the meeting to order. The clerk was asked to call roll, Council members Casey Whitman, Levoneia Ayers, George Ragland, Marvelene Freeman, Zach Atchley and Mayor Mary Caudle. Members present constituted a quorum.

Legal counsel Caleb Ballew was present via Facebook live and the clerk Sharron Humphrey was also present.

Motion by Whitman to approve the minutes dated April 13, 2020, Freeman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mayor Caudle's Report: Discussed the engineering contract with Engineers of the South.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

Fire & Police: Chairperson Atchley reported the Police Dept., logged 1,908 miles, made 7 traffic stops, 10 warning citations, 3 citations, 34 calls for service, 0 arrest and 10 reports.

Fire Dept., answered 10 medical calls, responded to 2 fire calls, 1 motor vehicle accident and traveled 42 miles.

Finance: No Report

Utility: No Report

Mayor Caudle reported she has studied the report with EOS Utility and is ready to move forward with phase 1 she asked council if they had any questions.

Motion by Atchley for Mayor Caudle to enter into a contract with OES Utility service at a cost of \$64,400.00, Ragland seconded the motion. Roll call vote, Whitman-yes, Ayers-yes, Ragland-yes, Freeman-yes, Atchley-yes and Caudle-yes. Unanimous consent, motion carried.

Park & Recreation: Chairperson Freeman asked Mayor Caudle to give update on gym project. Mayor Caudle reported new lights were in, bathroom flooring has been done, walls have been painted and they have completed the plumbing in bathrooms. They are halfway done. Gym should be ready by the fall.

Mayor Caudle also reported County will grade the football/soccer field when they open back up.

Theory Haywood President/Coach of the Triana Warriors football introduced his staff to the council, he stated they are no changes as of yet. Uniforms out, they will go with black, blue and white which will be their away jersey. They will push their home games to the back of schedule if field is not ready.

Field goal post has been ordered. He stated they will also have cheer completion.

Mayor Caudle stated we do have parents that don't do Facebook. She suggested dropping off registration packet at Town Hall. She wants all kids to be a part of the program.

Mr. Haywood stated he will have some registration forms dropped off at Town Hall and there's also some at the Dollar General Store. He asked if they could put up a sign on city property.

Mayor stated it would be ok.

Streets & Cemetery: Chairperson Whitman reported he sprayed for mosquitos this weekend and he also did a traffic study in Savannah Subdivision provided data to Chief.

RESOLUTIONS, ORDINANCES, ORDERS AND OTHER BUSINESS:

Mayor Caudle reported construction sites look better since the attorney sent out letters to contractors. We had the issue with contractors turning the water off and not notifying the town. Councilman Whitman reported burning is an issue, residents are burning plastic, shingles and tires he made the recommendation for the Town Council meet with the Fire Chief. Mayor stated council needs to look at having a work session to discuss the listed issues. Attorney Caleb Ballew was asked to draft a burn ordinance for the town.

We have two individuals to vote on the planning committee, Pasty Parvin and Jason Garstka. Motion by Freeman to add the two individuals to the Planning and Zoning Committee, Ragland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Councilman Whitman reported receiving a request for rezoning; Public hearing held, the developer is requesting to have property located on Zierdt Road rezoned to build multifamily townhomes on a 3rd of the 40 acres. They are working on it and he plans to keep the council informed. Mayor stated they will look at ways the developer can help with the sewer issue we're having.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Theresa Nelson stated she is concerned over the problem with the ~~rats~~ in collier. She has spoken with Ginger about getting someone out to spray.

There's a pothole on Wall Triana Hwy near Cable Dr. that needs to be filled in.

Mayor Caudle stated Councilman Whitman will look at that pothole when he finishes marking them around town.

Ms. Nelson also reported that the Joe Fletcher scholarship was awarded to two students from this area; they will each receive \$500.00.
