

Town of Triana
Regular Council Meeting
Monday, May 11, 2020
6:30p.m.

The mayor called the meeting to order. Clerk was asked to call the roll, Council members Casey Whitman, Levoneia Ayers, George Ragland, Marvelene Freeman, Zach Atchley and Mayor May Caudle. Members present constituted a quorum.

Legal counsel Caleb Ballew and the clerk Sharron Humphrey were also present.

Motioned by Whitman to approve the minutes date April 27, 2020 with correction, Ayers seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mayor Caudle's Report: Madison County Chairman Strong donated some mask to the town; residents can come by to pick one up if needed before entering the office.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

Fire & Police: Chairperson Atchley reported the Police Dept., Traveled 2,132 miles, made 25 Traffic stops, 24 Warning citations, and 3 Citations, 33 Calls for service, 0 Arrests and 3 Reports. Fire Dept., had 3 Medical calls and 1 Fire call. Chief reported they have 1 guy to call inquiring about experience requirement.

Finance: Chairperson Ayers presented the Bank Reconciliation Statement ending April 30, 2020. Motion by Ayers to approve the Bank Statement ending April 30, 2020, Ragland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Utility: Chairperson Ragland reported that the commercial meter has been installed on Swancott Rd. Still waiting on the lift station to be installed or repaired on Wall Triana Hwy. Mayor Caudle reported the following: Still waiting on Madison Utilities to get back with her, we had a pump repaired at entrance to Savannah Subdivision and Madison Utilities working to replace meter on Swancott hit a main water line resulting in them having to shut the whole system down.

Mayor thanked Attorney Caleb Ballew for getting the letters out to the contractors.

Park and Recreation: Chairperson Freeman asked for an update on gym renovation. Mayor Caudle reported repairs were still being done, contractor is on target. They are ready to order bleachers and scoreboard to be replaced. Contractor has agreed to paint utility poles out front grey and County to do the leveling on the field. Councilman Ragland reported Mr. Haywood has been riding around town signing kids up for football/cheer.

Mayor reported they've gotten their 501-C.

Streets & Cemetery: Chairperson Whitman reported County has patched Harold Murphy. Have a resident at 257 Harold Murphy Dr., who thinks there may be a sewer break causing the ground to rote out. We may want to contact Madison Utilities to look at drainage pipes.

RESOLUTIONS, ORDINANCES, ORDERS AND OTHER BUSINESS

Councilman Whitman suggested we send truck in to have alignment.

Councilman Ragland stated truck cannot be aligned because it needs to have some front end work done.

Councilmember Freeman suggested we have truck checked out to see what it needs.

Pothole reported on Ervin Lane.

Mayor Caudle reported town needs to take control of the burning it was not the intent to change things you just have to have a permit to control the burning.

Councilman Whitman made the suggestion to sell the old mower and dump truck.

Work session scheduled for Tuesday, May 26th at 6p.m.

Councilman Whitman stated at one time town was considering hiring our building inspector full-time. He stated this will with the issue we're having with keeping tabs on building and the development. We can put eyes on things when they're doing hydrant testing.

The clerk was asked to check what cities like New Hope and Gurley are paying their building inspectors.

Councilman Ragland reported we're having an issue with residents cutting down trees and moving the debris onto other people's property.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Shelia McNeil stated the property behind her house has drainage culvert, grass has grown high. She asked who is responsible for cutting it.

Mayor stated that subdivision has not been dedicated to the town. She plans to meet with the developer.

Ms. McNeil stated they have an issue with the mosquitos at the retaining pond she asked if town could put something in it where it moves.

Councilman Whitman stated they could modify the planning and zoning to require the HMO to pay to have something in the water.

Ms. McNeil expressed concern over a letter she received about the water possible not being safe.

Mayor Caudle explained that the town is a purchase system but we are required to still take water samples. We were in between hiring a water operator at the time sampling needed to be

done and we missed the due date to pull samples. When that happens ADEM requires the water system to let the customers know of the violation.

Theresa Nelson stated the Collier area needs to be sprayed for gnats.

Mayor stated she thought it was reported that someone would be down to spray.

Ms. Nelson stated no one has been out to spray. She also reported there's a street light out on Wall Triana & Landess Cir.

Mayor stated she will have the clerk to report it to Huntsville Utilities.

Ms. Nelson stated she heard that the town had masks to be given away.

Mayor stated the County brought out masks for when we have a function to make sure everyone is masked up or if someone comes down to pay their bill and needs on a mask to enter office we will have them on site. They are not to just be given away to the public.

Patsy Parvin stated they have some residents that burn constantly; she would like to be able to sit outside her home and not be run back inside because people are burning something that is unbearable. Town needs to consider charging a fine.
